University Scholarships

The Visions University Scholars Program, launched in 2015, offers holistic support services to high-achieving rural youth during their transition to higher education or the working world.

The cost of supporting one student is \$360/year (or just \$30/month) + \$250 one time purchase of a tablet.



After-School Programs

The Visions Learning and Empowerment Program (also referred to as our "afterschool program") is a multi-dimensional program that provides vital after-school support intended to foster the overall development of children and youth aged between 6 to 18. We currently have 22 centers serving nearly 900 youth.

The cost of sponsoring a center is \$1,200/year (or just \$100/month).

Blue Brick School

Support marginalized children globally with e-learning resources. Sponsor a tablet computer for \$250 each and help 5 young children learn English and Tamil literacy through Blue Brick School (www.BlueBrickSchool.org).

The one-time cost of one (1) tablet is \$250.



Menstrual Hygiene

Visions Adolescent Girls Associations promotes awareness of adolescent girls' rights, health, and hygiene, and provides reusable sanitary napkins and education on menstrual and reproductive health.

The one-time cost of three (3) reusable sanitary napkins is \$10.

Sanitary Needs

Empower a rural family, particularly elders and girls, by sponsoring the construction of a toilet for \$350. Your support will provide them with improved sanitation facilities and enhance their overall health and well-being.

The one-time cost of one (1) toilet with installation is \$350.
